### NOTICE OF INCOMPLETE APPLICATION

Dear Kate Costello,

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (Department or DEC) has reviewed the application submitted for the above referenced project, located at 1 Nevis Drive, New Windsor. According to the application materials, the proposal consists of reauthorizing a lapsed State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (SPDES) permit that expired on October 31, 2022. The permit authorized an existing surface discharge of 15,000 gallons per day of treated sanitary sewage to a tributary to unnamed tributary of Silver Stream Reservoir [Water Index Number H-P 225-1-2-P 226a-1, Class C], from a secondary treatment system at the facility, which operates as a manufactured home community.

Based on our review of the submitted materials, Department staff have determined that the application is incomplete. Please submit the following items for the Department to continue its review:

#### STATE POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (SPDES)

The technical review is complete.

   Once you have prepared your draft PPP, please submit it to the Department for review. Please ensure the link to the document repository is live and goes directly to the repository.
